

# MUNICIPAL ELECTION VOTER CHECKLIST



## Are you able to vote?

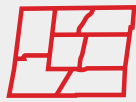
### To vote, you must be:

- A Canadian citizen; and
- 18 years of age or older; and
- A resident of the City of Markham; or
- A non-resident who is, or whose spouse is, an owner or tenant of land in the City of Markham; and
- Not prohibited from voting by law

- Mayor
- Regional Councillor
- Ward Councillor
- York Region District School Board Trustee
- York Catholic District School Board Trustee
- Conseil scolaire Viamonde Trustee
- Conseil scolaire catholique MonAvenir Trustee

## Did you receive your Voter Information Package (VIP) in the mail?

Your Voter Information Package (VIP) contains all the information you need to cast your ballot, including your Online Voting PIN. If you did not receive yours, you are not on the Municipal Voters' List. You must be on the list in order to vote.

### Here is how you can register:

- Online voter lookup tool until 7 p.m. on October 22;
- In person at the front desk at any Markham Public Library branch until October 19; or
- In person at any Voter Assistance Centre during Voting Days (October 12 - 22)

### ID Requirements:

- Photo ID; and
- Proof of Canadian Citizenship; and
- Proof of Markham residency or non-resident eligibility

*If you were on previous Provincial or Federal voters' lists, it does not mean you are on the Municipal Voters' List.*



## ONLINE

### October 12 - 22

- Vote anywhere, anytime from a computer or mobile device;
- In person on October 22 at ANY Voter Assistance Centre, using an election tablet; or
- On a public computer at any Markham Public Library branch



Voters can vote using their own assistive devices from the comfort of their own home, work or anywhere with an internet connection.



## PAPER BALLOT

### October 12 - 19

- Vote in person using a paper ballot at ANY Voter Assistance Centre



Accessibility devices available to assist voters.



No paper ballots available on Final Voting Day (October 22).
